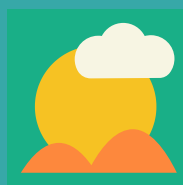

Puertas Abiertas: A Program of Alpine Achievers Initiative

Launched in December 2025, Puertas Abiertas was created by Alpine Achievers Initiative (AAI) to address the unique challenges faced by non-English-speaking and English-speaking families in the Arkansas River Valley. The program helps families access essential resources, navigate complex systems, and build long-term stability through bilingual and culturally responsive support.

Our Vision



When families can access the resources they need, children thrive, parents gain confidence, and communities become stronger. AAI is helping ensure that every family—regardless of language or background—has the opportunity to succeed.

Services of the Puertas Abiertas program include:

- Comprehensive case management
- Interpretation and language-accessible support
- Resource navigation and referrals
- Advocacy and systems navigation
- Emergency assistance coordination
- Connections to housing, healthcare, education, employment, and legal services

In only 6 months, Puertas Abiertas has provided intensive support to 23 families navigating complex systems in the Arkansas Valley.

Housing Stability

During the first few months:

- Families on the verge of homelessness were connected with the local housing authority and landlords to secure stable housing.
- Rental assistance applications helped families remain housed during medical crises and periods of unemployment.
- More than \$9,000 in housing assistance was leveraged through community partnerships and emergency funding programs.

Economic and Financial Stability

Families received support accessing:

- Employment opportunities
- Utility assistance
- Tax-fraud recovery resources
- Public benefits
- Community grants and emergency funds

Healthcare Access

Puertas Abiertas supported families with language barriers by:

- Coordinating emergency dental care
- Connecting families to local healthcare providers
- Scheduling preventive medical appointments
- Interpreting during appointments
- Completing Medicaid applications
- Applying for hospital discount programs and local grants to cover medical expenses

Puertas Abiertas

Total ideal investment: \$166,000

Growing Little Roots (Early Childhood Support)

- Diapers, formula, and food assistance for children under 5
 - \$2,400 × 20 children = \$48,000
- Two Bilingual Coordinators (15 hours/week, year-round)
 - \$78,000
- Emergency & Preventative Medical Support
 - \$13,000
- Immigration & Legal Support
 - \$17,000
- Emergency Rental Assistance
 - \$10,000
